ATTRACTIONS



Thomasville is more than a city in Davidson County. Its rich history in textiles and furniture has Thomasville commonly referred to as the "Chair City," in reference to a 30-foot landmark replica of a Duncan Phyfe armchair that rests in the middle of the city. As a 2013 All-America City, Thomasville knows the importance of looking to the future while maintaining its wonderful and rich history. We invite you to spend your day, weekend, or a lifetime with us!



THE BIG CHAIR

6 W Main St.



The original "Big Chair" was constructed in 1922 by the Thomasville Chair Company (later known as Thomasville Furniture Industries, TFI) out of lumber and Swiss steer hide to reflect the city's prominent furniture industry. However, in 1936, after 15 years of exposure to the elements the oversized replica chair was removed. In 1951, a larger steel and concrete version of the chair was erected with the collaboration of local businesses and civic organizations. This is the same chair you see today! The Big Chair gained national attention in 1960 when then Vice Presidential candidate, Lyndon B. Johnson greeted supporters on the monument during a campaign whistle stop. Can you imagine climbing a ladder to stand in a chair so tall? Although larger ones have been built, many Thomasville residents still boast that the Big Chair between the two main streets is the "World's Largest Chair." This monument is a popular tourist attraction. Decorated with hundreds of tulips every spring, and a Santa hat at Christmas, the Big Chair is a photo op you must experience for yourself!

HISTORIC MURALS

Downtown



Thomasville has an incredible public art scene! There are 18 murals in the downtown area alone, showcasing art ranging from beautiful animals to historic sites with nostalgic scenes, as well as modern thought-provoking pieces. Choosing your favorite may be a challenge. Various groups and businesses within the community have commissioned different pieces showcasing an array of artists' work. DEPOT/VISITORS CENTER 44 W Main St.

The Thomasville Railroad Passenger Depot, est. 1871, is one of the oldest surviving frame depots in North Carolina. Originally

located on the south side of the railroad tracks, it served as a passenger depot until 1912, at which time a brick depot (no longer standing) was erected. The frame depot was then moved to the north side of the tracks, where it served for many years as the freight agent's office. After it ceased to use the building, the Southern Railway Company gave the depot to the city. It was restored in the 1970s and listed in the National Register in 1981. Today it serves as Thomasville's Visitor Center where you can find a concierge to help you plan your visit to Thomasville.



TRAIN WATCHING On both sides of Main St.

Thomasville offers safe, hassle-free train watching all around downtown. The tracks parallel Main Street and provide some of

the best train watching in the country. Known for long, straight, flat stretches downtown Thomasville is great for rail fans and tourists alike. With over 40 trains passing through the heart of historic downtown Thomasville on Norfolk Southern's main line in a 24-hour period, our town is perfect for photographers and videographers to get shots of various trains. Locally-owned train hobby shop, Mike's Trains on East Main Street, provides a place for train enthusiasts to gather and anticipate the next train to go zipping by.



CIVIL WAR TRAILS/ CITY CEMETARY 205 Memorial Park Dr.

You can follow the three Civil War Trails landmarks around downtown. One at the Depot, one by the clocktower and

one in our unique City Cemetery. In 1862, during the Confederate War, fleeing civilians from war-torn parts of eastern North Carolina found refuge in Thomasville. Two hundred and eighty men arrived by train from the Averasboro battlefield in March 1865, seeking mending in the Baptist and Methodist Churches which were pressed into service as hospitals. The L.L. Thomas Hotel served as headquarters, and eventually 34 soldiers from the war died in Thomasville—including 26 Confederates, 4 Federals, and 4 unknown. What makes this cemetery unique is all soldiers are buried together in the common plot. In 1908, a Georgian who had served in the hospital raised funds to provide headstones for the dead as a tribute to the soldiers' sacrifices and to the dedication of the local residents who had tended them.



WALKING TRAILS 44 W Main St.

There are three self-guided historical walking trails in Downtown Thomasville that begin at the Visitors Center. The

following trails are less than 1 mile, and are handicapped/stroller friendly. The Church Walk is .82 miles and passes several sites of former churches that were used as makeshift hospitals during the Civil War. The Commerce Walk is .6 miles and goes by downtown businesses, the clocktower, the fountain, and a variety of shops as well as murals. The Historic Homes Walk is .87 miles and takes you through the Salem Street Historic District where you can see homes from the mid-1800's! Detailed walking trail brochures are available in the Visitors Center or download the free app "PocketSights" to follow along on your phone.



FINCH FIELD

7003 Ball Park Rd.

Generational. The one term that defines the true essence of Finch Field. Built in 1935 by Thomasville Furniture Industries, the ballpark has served area residents recovering from the horrors of World War I, to locals keeping pace with the speed of the internet age. Constructed as a recreational outlet for T.F.I. employees, Finch Field has hosted everything from junior high school track meets to religious revivals. Undoubtedly, however, Finch Field's status in the High Point/ Thomasville community is best defined by its role as the area's epicenter of baseball. Initially serving as the home park for the Thomasville Chairmakers in the Class D Carolina State League, Finch Field has served as the home park for the area's American Legion programs, Thomasville High School Baseball team, city youth recreational baseball leagues and the area's most prominent baseball club, the HiToms. Over 75 years-old, Finch Field embarks upon another stage of its life. Outfitted with a new look and a rejuvenated purpose, the old ballpark is poised to provide this generation with a new chapter of family memories and opportunities destined to engrain themselves in the unifying novel entitled: Finch Field: A Generation of Community Memories. Finch Field is owned by the City of Thomasville. Today, you can still catch fun baseball games running May- October. hitoms.com/schedule

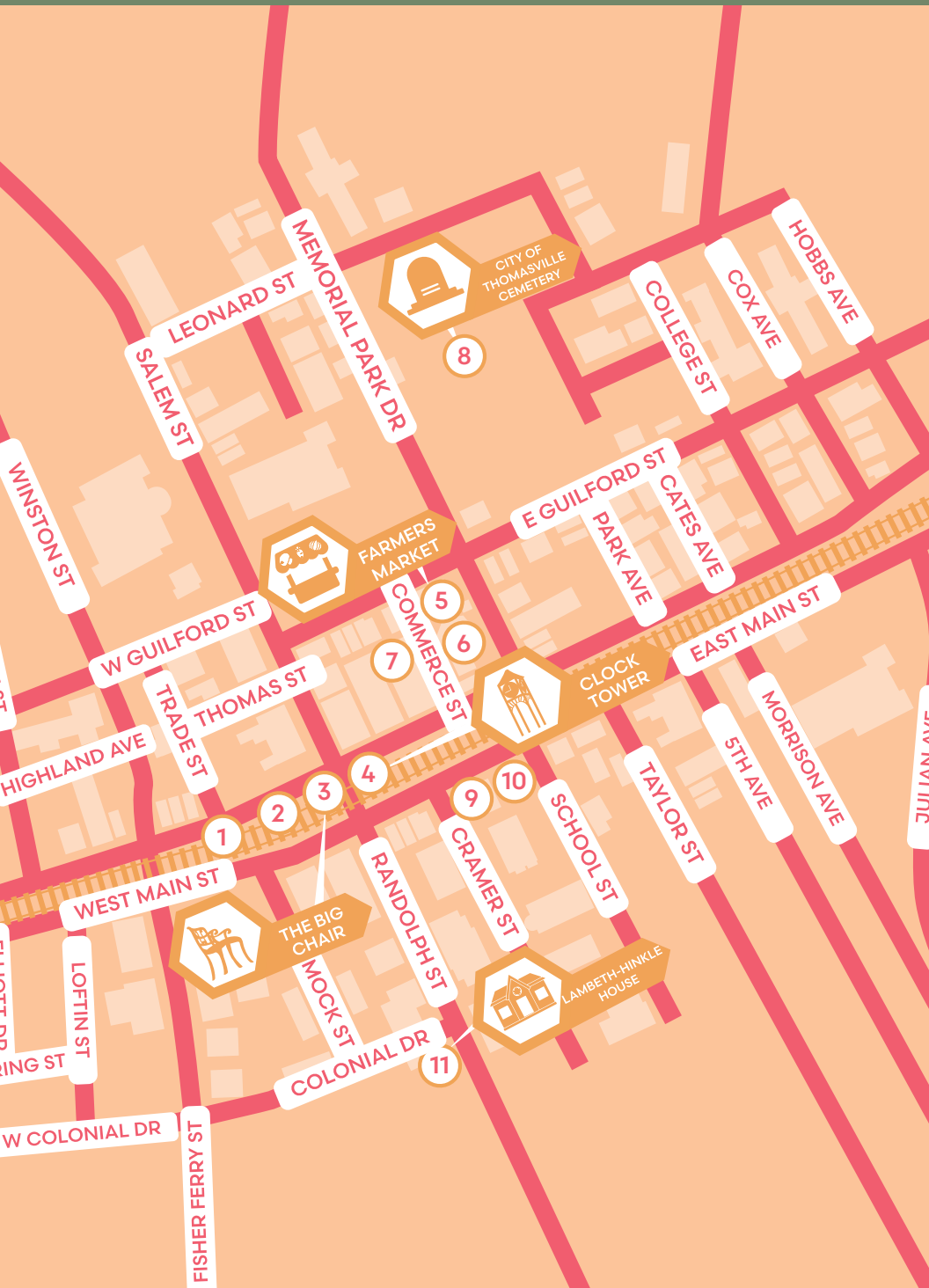
